Surrey Sports Park opened in April 2010. Built by the University of Surrey, this £36m elite training venue is already a sporting hub in the South East of Britain. Its location, being close to London and both major airports gives it an advantage over many other training venues.

Surrey Sports Park has facilitated many training camps in rugby, football, swimming, basketball and netball as well as hosting many national and international events, most notably the IRB Women's Rugby World Cup 2010, and the Rathbones Women's Lacrosse World Cup 2017.

On site accommodation, experienced professionals and state of the art facilities make Surrey Sports Park the choice of champions.

FACILITIES



INDOOR SWIMMING POOL

- Size: 50m x 20m
- 8 x 2.5m wide lanes
- Traversable boom enabling the pool to become 2 x 25m sections, or 30m long for water polo
- Moveable floor enabling the depth of the water to change. Whilst the pool is 2m deep throughout, it can change at the touch of a button and rise to any depth up to deck level.
- Daktronics timing system and wall mounted 4m x 2m video screen
- OSB12 starting platforms with athletic start and relay break detection
- UV water treatment system
- Wet side changing village, dedicated to pool users

HEALTH AND FITNESS CENTRE

- Size: 700sq m
- 120 Stations, including the latest CV equipment with integrated TV and entertainment systems, fixed resistance machines and free weights
- World class, Olympic standard equipment to cater for our elite athletes
- 9 Olympic lifting platforms

3 MULTI-PURPOSE SPORTS HALLS

- Size: 34m x 18m (Halls A and B set as Performance Arena 34m x 36m)
- Individually available as 3 separate halls, ideal as training facilities or multi-sport use
- Electronic retractable bleacher seating for 820 people, with additional seating available
- Fully sprung wooden floor
- Suitable for basketball, badminton, netball, volleyball, martial arts, archery, fencing, table tennis and trampolining (list not exhaustive)
- All equipment complies with National Governing Body standards
- Floor anchors for gymnastic equipment

2 LARGE MULTI-PURPOSE EXERCISE STUDIOS

- Size: 15m x 12m (individual)
- Size: 15m x 24m (retractable wall open)
- Fully sprung wooden floor
- Mirrored walls with drapes
- Suitable for dance, group fitness, martial arts or a team meeting space.
- Suitable for mass catering.

1 SMALL MULTI-PURPOSE STUDIO

- Fully sprung wooden floor.
- Ideal for dance and well-being sessions such as pilates, yoga and tai chi.

SPINNING STUDIO

- Contains 25 Spinning bikes
- Suitable for junior fitness classes and interactive dance platform sessions

6 GLASS-BACKED SQUASH COURTS

- 2 show courts with electronic, retractable seating for 132 spectators and Daktronics scoring system
- 4 further courts with permanent raised bench seating

CLIMBING CENTRE

- 12m overhanging competition wall
- Resin-featured lead wall suitable for lessons, social climbers or children's parties
- Abseiling ledge
- Extensive bouldering wall, incorporating a bouldering cave suitable for advanced climbers

CHANGING FACILITIES

- Dedicated changing options for each facility, including – Wet-side, Fitness Change, Gym-Swim and Sport Specific
- Sauna and Steam facilities

THE TREATMENT ROOM

- Offering sports massage, sports therapy, osteopathy and physiotherapy.

TEAM ROOMS

- To assess performances, team discussions, management discussions
- Medical testing
- Full catering

BAR AND SOCIAL AREAS

- Outdoor terrace overlooking the grass and artificial pitches
- Europe's first Starbucks in a Sports Park, featuring 120 indoor seats and outdoor seating - overlooking artificial and grass pitches

OUTDOOR FACILITIES

- 3 Artificial turf pitches, including two 3G rubber crumb pitches
- 8 grass football/rugby pitches
- 8 floodlit tennis courts

- The latest CCTV equipment monitors Surrey Sports Park with over 50 cameras centrally managed.

- The Surrey Sports Park is serviced by a large number of University of Surrey modern accommodation rooms on site (not available all year around)
- The rooms are single, en suite with internet connection
- They are in clusters of 5-8 around a shared kitchen area

PERFORMANCE SERVICES

SURREY HUMAN PERFORMANCE INSTITUTE

At our on-site Surrey Human Performance Institute, our practitioners work daily with athletes and coaches as part of their elite performance programmes. We work in multi-disciplinary teams to provide a holistic service that supports coaches and performance directors in helping to improve and monitor the training, preparation and performance of their athletes.

What we do enables athletes to optimise training and practice; assists athletes to achieve peak performance at major tournaments and events, enables athletes and coaches to prevent, reduce and manage injuries; helps athletes and coaches to manage pressure and stress; and deploys performance enhancing technology, insight and analysis to enable athletes to develop strategies to support them for competition.

RFUW WORLD CUP 2010

- Surrey Sports Park hosted the 2010 Women's Rugby World Cup.
- 12 teams from around the world spent 3 weeks living, training and performing at Surrey Sports Park.
- All match and training pitches, accommodation, catering, physiotherapy and team rooms were supplied and maintained by Surrey Sports Park.

RUGBY WORLD CUP 2015 TRAINING BASE

- Surrey Sports Park hosted Ireland, Georgia, Italy, South Africa and Scotland for the 2015 Rugby World Cup.

HARLEQUINS

- Harlequins Rugby Union are located at Surrey Sports Park as their training venue.
- They have access to the 120 station fitness suite, making use of the Olympic standard heavy weights area and strength and conditioning facilities, as well as their own dedicated outdoor facilities.
- Harlequins will link into the University of Surrey Rugby club to develop players and improve pathways into elite sport.

SURREY STORM NETBALL

- Surrey Sports Park operates a Super League Netball team in England Netball's top level competition.
- All training sessions and matches take place at Surrey Sports Park.
- Athletes have full access to the fitness suite and work with the catering team to develop nutritionally balanced diets.

SURREY SCORCHERS

- Surrey Sports Park operates a British Basketball League team in the top level competition nationally.
- All training sessions and home games are held at Surrey Sports Park.
- Players and coaches from the club link in with the University Basketball Club, running all training and coaching.

LACROSSE WORLD CUP 2017

- 24 teams worldwide
- Hosted & accommodated at SSP for 2 weeks.
- All match/training pitches, accommodation, catering and meeting rooms were supplied & maintained by SSP.

GB BASKETBALL

- GB Women's basketball were based at Surrey Sports Park for their training camps and test matches in 2010 & 2011.

GUILDFORD CITY SWIMMING CLUB

- Guildford City Swimming Club is based at Surrey Sports Park.
- GCSC were the South East Regional National Swimming League Champions for 4 straight years from 2005-2008.
- Surrey Sports Park employs 2 ASA Level 4 coaches, plus 13 professionally qualified ASACoaches & Teachers, including its own in-house chartered physiotherapist and nutritionist.

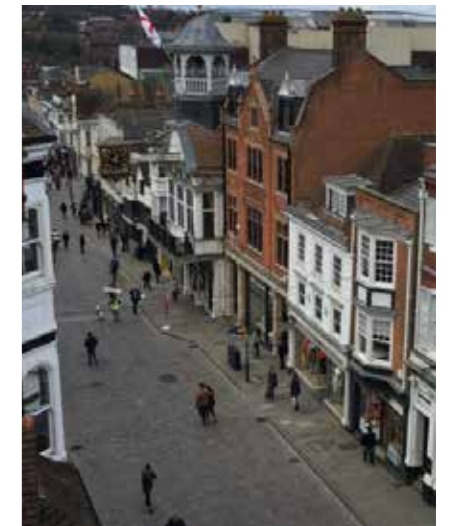
